NESTING BOX & BIRD FEEDER





What is a garden without birds?

The bird feeder and nesting box are the first examples of Gloster's introduction of smaller accessories designed to heighten the outdoor experience. The objective was a very rigorous one... to design highly functional items that served their intended purpose perfectly in combination with the sophistication of the Gloster design philosophy. A great deal of research and consultation was undertaken to ensure that these designs were entirely fit for use and practical.

The nesting box uses a powder coated aluminium housing to enclose a solid teak wood box in which the bird will build the nest. The nesting box can be wall attached or mounted on a pole. The internal wooden box can be removed from within the housing (it is retained inside using magnets) for cleaning. The box inside has an open top and space between it and the aluminium to allow for air circulation and drainage and to help with insulating against excess heat and/or cold. The interior of the box allows room for the hatchlings of smaller birds (Wren, Nuthatch, Sparrow) to grow. The small access hole is appropriate for these species and helps prevent intrusion by predators and larger birds. The nesting box does not use a perch deliberately, as this can also help predators hold onto the box.

The bird feeder uses powder coated aluminium and solid teak elements in combination and can either be suspended with a hanging wire (included) or pole mounted. It incorporates a funnel shaped cover which serves both to prevent squirrel access and to keep food dry. There are two feeder trays to allow different food types to be used, with the bottom tray being sealed to allow it to be used for water (it is often forgotten that birds needs a continuous supply of water even in winter months). The spacing between the trays determines the bird size and type that can access the feeder, and will not allow for pigeons for example to use it. The bird feeder is modular and can be taken apart easily for essential regular cleaning.
