MOOD BOARD USERS GUIDE



The Gloster Mood Board is an application for both private and professional users allows you to put together a scratchboard of your own ideas, using swatches of our fabrics and materials. Your own images can also be uploaded and included within their finished mood board. A standard grid of overlapping image windows can be combined with multiple header images, your own project title and text to create a personalised mood board that, when finished, can be quickly be exported into a PDF.

STAGE 1 - ADDING A TITLE & TEXT

The Mood Board page opens with multiple empty windows into which you can add content. At the very top of the page are two buttons called 'Add Title' and 'Add Text' where you can type in a title name for your mood board title and any further text you may wish to include to explain the details of the project and/or content etc. Click on the buttons and type in the text required. The title text will display in large type size and the additional text will display in small type size. If you do not want to include either a title and/or the additional text, just leave the windows un-filled and they will not be show on the final PDF when exported.

STAGE 2 - ADDING HEADER IMAGES

Underneath the text windows you now have the option to add header images. To add a header image, click on the 'Add Header Image' button. A window will now appear with links in bottom left corner to either 'Select Image' or 'Remove Image'. To add an image, click on 'Select Image'. A pop-up window will now appear with various pre-loaded images from the Gloster image database. Lifestyle Images are shown in alphabetical order by collection name. Scroll through the images, select the image you want to include and then click on the 'Select' button in bottom right corner of the window. The selected image is now added as a header image. To select your own image, select the 'Upload Image' option and then click on the 'Select Image' button. Browse your device to find the image you want to add and then click on the 'Select' button in bottom right corner of the window. The selected image is now added as a header image.

Any number of header images can be added by clicking on the 'Add Header Image' button. To remove the image entirely or replace with an alternative image, simply click on the 'Remove Image' link at the base of each window and either leave the window blank or begin the image selection procedure again. If you do not want to include any header images just leave the windows un-filled and they will not be show on the final PDF when exported.

STAGE 3 - POPULATING THE MOOD BOARD

Underneath the text windows and header images, you will see a grid of 5 windows that comprises the mood board itself. The windows are fixed in both their size and position and cannot be scaled or re-ordered. To add materials to the mood board, select the window you want to populate, then click on the on the 'Select Image' link in bottom left corner. A pop-up window will now appear with various preloaded images from the Gloster image database. Fabric images are shown by fabric collection (Outdoor Performance, Soft Touch, Water Resistant). Materials are shown by material type (Ceramic, Glaze, Powder Coat, Rope, Deco Rugs, Sling, Stone / Glass, Strap, Teak, Wicker). Lifestyle Images are shown in alphabetical order by collection name. Scroll through the images, select the image you want to include and then click on the 'Select' button in bottom right corner of the window. The selected image is now added to the mood board. To select your own image, select the 'Upload Image' option and then click on the 'Select image' option and then click on the 'Select image is now added to the mood board. The mood board image you want to add and then click on the 'Select' button in bottom right corner of the window. The selected image is now added to the mood board.

To remove the image entirely or replace with an alternative image, simply click on the 'Remove Image' link at the base of each window and either leave the window blank or begin the image selection procedure again. If you do not want to populate all 5 windows in the mood board grid, just leave the windows un-filled and they will not be show on the final PDF when exported.

STAGE 4 - EXPORTING THE MOOD BOARD

Once you are satisfied that your mood board is finished, click on the 'Save as PDF' button at the base of the page. A new browser window or tab will open with a PDF version of the final mood board. The title, additional text and header images (if selected) appears on the first pages of the PDF. The mood board itself will appear on the final page of the PDF. From this window or tab you can now save or download the exported PDF to your device.

Please note that once you close or navigate away from the mood board page, the website will not remember any of your previous selections and you will have to start from the beginning again with an empty template.
